McAfee has updated their VirusScan program to catch it, but be careful. Don't open strange Email attachments. To learn more about Viruses and Trojans call for our free document 901081. Intel is preparing to release it's new processor - the Pentium III - in March, with speeds starting at 450 and 500 MHz.
