A: Wayne, first copy the picture from your hard drive and paste it into the images folder in your Web. Then, drag the picture to your Web page. Click once on the picture and from the Pictures toolbar that appears, click on Auto Thumbnail. When you save your page, you'll be asked to save your thumbnail image. Q: Whenever I apply columns to my Word documents, the whole page changes. How can I turn on columns for only half the page? > Erin, Depew NY

A: Erin, first select (highlight) the text you wish to put into columns. Then, click on Format > Columns. Choose the number of columns you want, and then on the bottom of that window, make sure "Selected Text" appears in the Apply To box.
